Here are the words your student will encounter this week. Included are all the words that start with 'Ll'. Some words may be long, but don't worry, your student only needs to know what letter these words start with!








### Day 1 - Which Pictures Start with 'LI'?

Connect all the pictures that start with 'l' to the 'Ll' partners in the center!






### Day 2 - Connecting the L's

Connect the center letter to it's parter letters.




